Parking Details

All participants should try to be downtown on Saturday, May 18 by 6:30 a.m. and Sunday, May 19 before 6:00 a.m., when many of the roads are shut down.

Skip searching for parking and ride the train ('Rapid') or bus downtown. RTA's trains come to Tower City and buses to Public Square, steps away from where the race begins. <u>Click here for details</u>!

8:00am - 10:30am on Saturday, May 18 8:00am - 2:00pm on Sunday, May 19




Nuun On Course and Finish Line Hydration
